



ONLINE HOSTED CONTENT

The New Zealand healthcare sector is small and the chances are your customers have known you, and your products, for a long time. This may be a good thing, but it also means they may have developed assumptions about your people, products and company, some of which you may wish to challenge.

Online hosted content is your opportunity to have a more in-depth conversation with our readers, maybe launch new products or remind your customers what it is you do well or differently to your competitors. Position 2 - side bar position on the right hand side. Both these positions click through to your content page. You are also able to archive your hosted content on our site. Hosted content is searchable and sharable through social media. Also, users don't have to be logged in to our sites to read the content.

Your hosted content will be clearly marked as hosted; we want our readers to know that it is different from our editorial content to ensure our reader's expectations are met.



SUBMITTING YOUR ONLINE HOSTED CONTENT

Your hosted content will be successful if your material is engaging and relevant to our readership. For The Health Media staff to load your hosted content, we need the following fields provided. Fields with asterisks are mandatory; however, we strongly recommend that content for all fields is provided.

HOMEPAGE

1. Image or video space *

This is the image that will show on the front page of the website in the hosted content position you have booked and as the main image above your content. This image should pop and be compelling for your desired reader, enticing them to click on the link to read the full story.

Hero front position image/video size:
627 pixels (W) x 595 pixels (H)

Side bar front page position image/video size:
215 pixels (W) x 204 pixels (H)

2. Title *
Should be catchy, to entice the reader. No more than 5 words.



3. Introduction (Synopsis)*
Displayed on the website homepage, this is a compelling sentence describing the story for the reader.

4. Author *
Who has written the content. We can include a small, round icon to improve recognition of the author.

5. Date *
The date and time of publication is displayed and can be scheduled for an advance date.

6. Slug

The slug is displayed below the title in red capitals, and says the piece is an advert and not editorial.

7. Caption

This should be a short subtitle, describing your hero media image.

8. Standfirst

This is a brief introduction to the story that would appear above the main body of copy. It is not always needed and is usually used as a brief description of the story, introducing it to the reader.

Shark attacks in New Zealand used to be rare, but after a record year in 2017, including a fatal attack in the Hauraki Gulf last week, New Zealand Coast Guard needs more funds to invest in shark monitoring equipment.

Subheading and paragraphs

The story may have one or many paragraphs included. Each paragraph can have a subheading and image added. Charts or maps may also be added, if desired.

9. Subheading



10. Paragraph

11. Image

If an image or chart is added, you may also provide a caption which will be displayed below the image within the paragraph.

12. Pull quote

A pull quote is a quote that is copied and pulled out of the text to highlight a point and grab the reader's attention.

"It was quite horrifying really"

Related articles

A related article is a link to another related story or video on the *New Zealand Doctor* or *Pharmacy Today* website. This may be one of your earlier pieces of online hosted content.

13. Related links

You can use this field to link to another website. You will be asked for the URL of the website and the link text for each link. You can link to as many websites as you like.

14. Mandatories

You may wish to display some mandatory information adjacent to your content. A place is provided for this. Again, this is a free text HTML box.

Tags

A tag is a keyword assigned to information to help describe an item and allows it to be found again by browsing or searching. We use a set of controlled vocabulary on our website. Let us know what tags you think may be appropriate, and we will tag for you.


